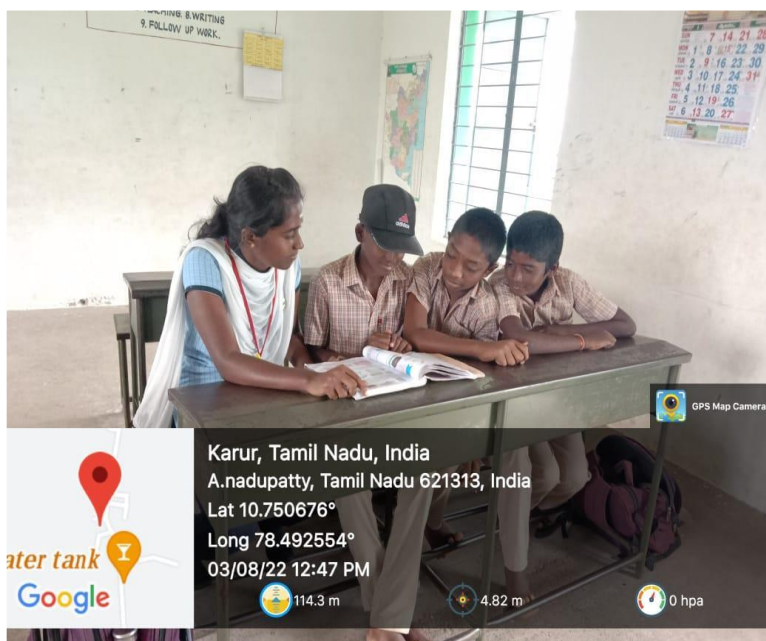
3.Temple Cleaning Activity:

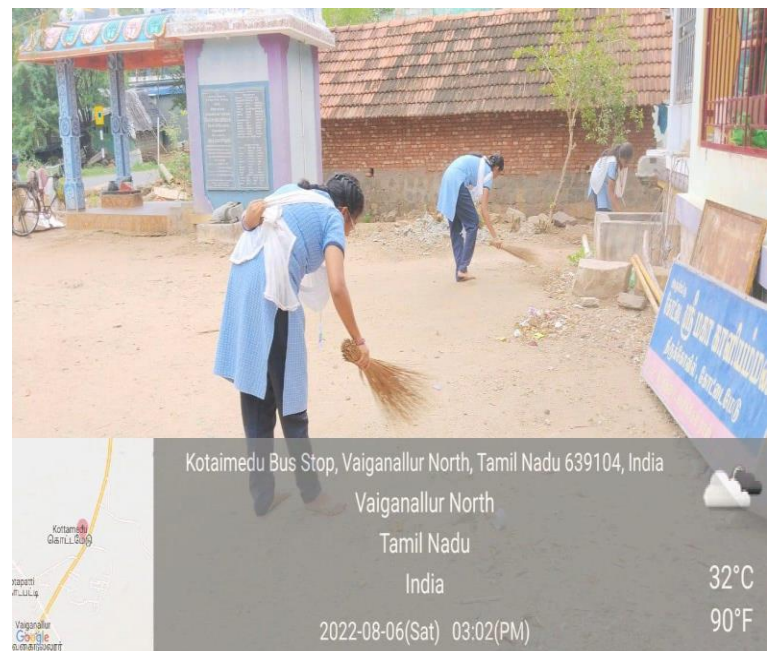
4.Tree Plantation Awareness Activity

Engineering was involved in creating discipline and education awareness at Nathapatti on 2nd August 2022.



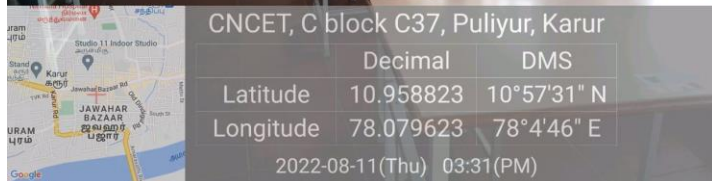
13.Essay Writing Competition

Second Prize: M.S.Niranjana, IV-CSE



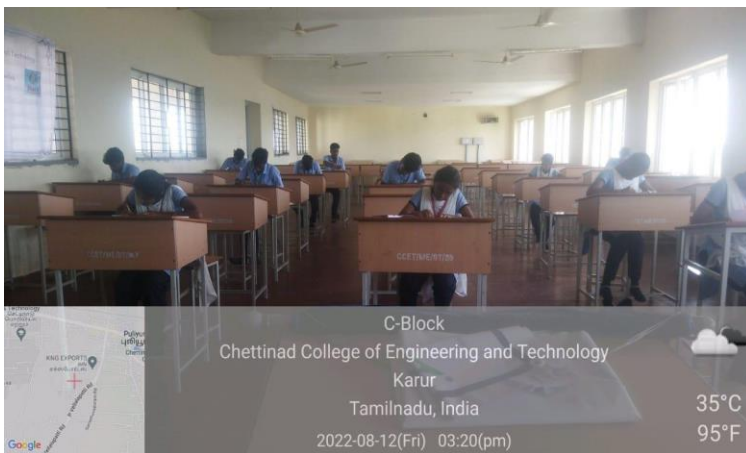
14. Drawing Competition

Second Prize: Emilin Pearl Sharal, IV-ECE



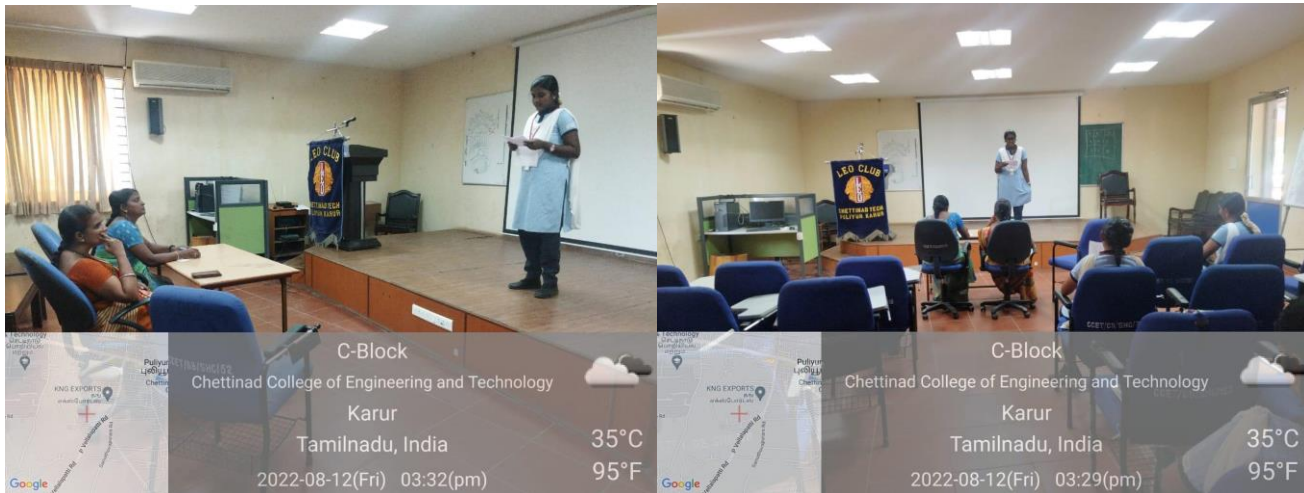
15.Tamil solo singing Competition
